Italy (Turin)

January 3

We started off the day having a time of fellowship and prayer at the church in Milan, both corporately with the local saints in Milan and the Bologna team, as well as just our team designated for Turin. Our fellowship focused on praying for those that the Lord is preparing in Turin, the sons of peace. We prayed for our group as a whole that we would be in one accord through the prayer, the Spirit, and the Word.

After our meeting, we departed for Turin (2-hour ride). Satan's attacks on the Lord's move were evident, as an hour away from our destination, the train had to make an emergency stop, and everyone had to unboard. Despite this delay, one woman prayed to receive the Lord on the ride, and another young man exchanged contact information with one of the saints. While we thought we would have to wait several hours for the trains to resume, some saints from Turin offered to come and drive the saints group by group to their living arrangements. Praise the Lord for the Body!

We ended the night with dinner, with some groups in the homes.



January 4

We had a Lord's table meeting with local saints from Turin and the surrounding cities. There were around 60 saints, including the gospel team and local saints. We were able to have lunch with all the saints in a nearby restaurant, which was a wonderful time of blending! Some saints were able to host local saints at their Airbnb for a time of more blending. Later in the day, many gospel tracts were passed out throughout the city.

January 5

We started the day with coordination and we read *The World Situation and the Direction of the Lord's Move*. Then with much prayer we went out for the gospel and divided into two groups. Group A tabled at Palazzo Nuovo at the University of Turin and Group B tabled at the bus station.
