January 7, 2026

EUROPE

Italy (Bologna)

January 2

The saints from the Bologna and Turin gospel trips arrived in Milan and gathered at the meeting hall. We had a time of fellowship and prayer in which the brothers released the burden of the gospel trips and the saints introduced themselves. It was a sweet time to be gathered from many localities to pray together for the Lord's move in Italy.

January 3

We began the day with orientation and divided into our subteams for prayer. Our fellowship focused on maintaining the one accord and praying that each saint would gain remaining fruit through long-term contacts. In the evening, after traveling to Bologna, we gathered again for prayer and coordination. This time was very sweet, and a family from Padua opened their Airbnb to host our daily coordination times.



January 4

On the Lord's Day, we met with Italian saints from nearby localities for blending and fellowship. We shared a meal together and heard the testimony of a couple in Bologna who are eager for the Lord to gain more in the city. They opened their restaurant for meetings and future appointments. Some saints also traveled to nearby cities, including Rimini, to fellowship with seeking believers who desire further shepherding.

January 5

We went out for the gospel and divided into two groups. One group tabled at Piazza Maggiore, and the other went to the University of Bologna. The Lord prepared several seeking ones, including a man who read from *Basic Elements of the Christian Life* and testified boldly of his assurance of salvation. Others were open to further fellowship and to attending the gospel dinner. Some saints also went to Rimini to table and fellowship with local believers.



January 6

The saints continued to labor in busy areas of the city. Despite snowy weather, many were drawn through singing. Several joined in singing hymns, and some received *Basic Elements of the Christian Life*. In the evening, the saints passed out gospel tracts at Piazza Minghetti during the Olympics Torch Relay. Many were open, and one woman prayed to receive the Lord.
